Dave Nichols introduced the Bettendorf schools superintendent, Dr. Theron Shutte. Dr. Shutte shared with the club the plans for the high school addition and remodeling and the addition at Hoover Elementary.



Dr. Shutte said these projects were funded with the one cent sales tax and also the plant and equipment fund. The project at Hoover is on schedule and is planned to be finished by the beginning of next school year.

The BHS project has a total price tag of \$13 million. It includes a new performing arts center/auditorium. The new space will seat 840 that will double the size of the current auditorium. Adjacent

to the auditorium will be a new administrative wing. All administrators including all district administrators will be housed here with a new main entrance to the school. The new entrance will make the school more secure.

The media center will be remodeled with more technology offerings.

The addition at Hoover will add four additional classrooms that will be used for early childhood education and a new common area. This is a \$3 million project.
