have all children enter school ready to learn. The program limits class size to 20 children, has licensed teachers, and must meet 10 hours a week. A big part of the program is involving family with home visits, conferences, and a family night. Currently 12,000 four year olds are being served in the state wide program with 1,192 children locally in the program.
